Instructions for gatherings are as follows:

The Volunteer to Host:

1. Will request the dates people are available for the next get-together.
2. Will ask for suggestions for the next location to hold the gathering
3. Make a reservation for the estimated number that will be attending and find out when the restaurant requires a final head count.
4. Will Email the group about the plans and ask them if they are available to come. The Pastor and wife should be emailed an invitation.
5. Will email the group about five days before the date the restaurant needs the final count to confirm they will be coming and if they have any transportation needs.
6. Contact the restaurant with the final count.
7. During each fellowship time the group will seek a volunteer to organize the next gathering.
