

St Luke's Reopening to Sanctuary Instructions

- 1 St. Luke's UMC Services will resume in sanctuary on July 18, 2021
- 2 There will be two (2) services, one at 8:30 a.m. and the second at 10:00 a.m.
- 3 The Church will be sanitized before the building reopens
- 4 The pews will be wiped down, with sanitizing wipes between services
- 5 Acolytes are encouraged for both services.
- 6 Greeters will be present to hold open doors, for a contactless entrance and exit
- 7 Greeters will take temperatures, and admit those within CDC standards.
- 8 Greeters will direct attendees to a stack of Hymnals and weekly bulletins, from which they may take the top booklet
- 9 Hymnals are for first service only! Please take one per family, take it home and bring it to our weekly service. Please bring your own Bible, as none will be provided.
- 10 Bibles will be packed away. Please bring your own.
- 11 Communion will be of the individual sealed type, distributed by gloved assistants
- 12 The 8:30 Service will not require social distancing, masks are optional
- 13 The 10:00 Service will have at least 1/2 of the building dedicated to social distancing
- 14 The 8:30 Service will allow singing by the congregation
- 15 The 10:00 Service will not allow singing by the congregation
- 16 The 8:30 Service will allow the Passing of the Peace, and closing "Till We Meet" if comfortable
- 17 The 10:00 Service will not have a Passing of the Peace nor closing contact
- 18 It is recommended that those who are not vaccinated attend the second service, or refrain from attending in-person church services. Our services will still be available to you on our web page, and on YouTube.
- 19 There will be collection plates available for your donations at entrances and exits. Please continue to make your Tithes and Offerings via check Payable To: St Luke's UMC
